Rally on the Steps

Plan to join PTA advocates from across the state in Olympia for the WSPTA annual Focus Day. A full day of activities is planned, centered around a large public rally of the membership on the front steps of the Legislative Building at 12:00 noon.

All members, along with legislative representatives and the media, are invited to hear keynote speakers, meet with legislators and show support for children's issues.

The Basic Education Finance Joint Task Force (BEF), a bipartisan group appointed by the Governor, will release its final report on Dec. 1st. This committee is tasked with two key assignments:

- Redefine Basic Education, and
- Develop appropriate funding structures that are fair, adequate and accountable.

Lawmakers will need our state-wide support for legislation to begin in the Feb. '09 budget session that calls for full funding of public education!
